

The Swedish society for alcohol and drug research

(Svenska föreningen för Alkohol- och Drogforskning, SAD) and the Swedish Society for Addiction Medicine (Svensk förening för Beroendemedicin) invite you to participate at our joint research meeting on November 7-8 in Skövde.

The overall title of the meeting is:

“The concept of addiction as a chronic relapsing brain disorder - helpful or harmful?”

Ongoing Swedish research will be presented shortly at day two, during two sessions of short 10-15 min presentations. We now invite you to submit an abstract for this day. Research from all areas within the addictions field is eligible. In total twelve abstracts will be selected. Abstracts from ongoing projects, and as yet unpublished data are prioritized. You are welcome to submit an abstract as a PhD, postdoc or project leader or any other position. Only one abstract per project will be accepted. Abstract can be submitted in English or Swedish, but presentation should be in Swedish, with slides in English.

Unfortunately we have no possibility to reimburse your travel fees, conference cost of lodgings.

Welcome to submit your abstract containing the following information:

- Title and authors on the top of the page
- Text should be maximum 250 words (excluding title)
- Maximum 2 objects (tables/ figures) in the abstract
- Structure: Background, method, results, conclusions
